
Democracy



Long-term outcomes are outside of direct control and depend on national/international context and the level of autocratisation, as illustrated by the following assumptions.

Global normative processes influence national governments

International and national actors give civil society access to meaningful participation

Civil society is legitimate and accountable

Coordinated efforts by civil society will increase political will to protect civic space locally, regionally and internationally

Civil society set aside competition and collaborate

Civil society utilizes knowledge on how best to protect and enhance civic space
