

Core indicators¹

Core indicator 1: Number and type of policies² influenced³ by partner's work.

Core indicator 2: Volume/share/scope⁴ of relevant total covered by the influenced policy.

Core indicator 3: Area (km²) with acknowledged Indigenous land tenure or use rights.

Core indicator 4: Area (km²) with sustainable natural resource management.

Core indicator 5: Number of people reached with livelihood activities, disaggregated by sex.⁵

Core indicator 6: Proportion of partner's funding that reaches IPs directly.

Core indicator 7: Proportion of produced information⁶ on organized crime, illegal gold mining, converging crime or key perpetrators that has influenced a reaction⁷ by relevant public authorities or private actors (%/total).

Core indicator 8: Number of companies and financial institutions exposed to increased pressure (through targeted campaigns, legal complaints etc.)

Core indicator 9: Number of public reactions or changed practices from companies and financial institutions, influenced by the partners' work.

Core indicator 10: Volume of investments influenced by the partner's work, disaggregated by:

- a) Investments phased out of businesses or activities with a high risk of causing deforestation (USD)
- b) Investments redirected to, retained in, or invested in deforestation-free businesses or activities (USD)

⁴ *Volume/share/scope* may include, but are not limited to: geographic area, jurisdiction, share of population/target group, share of supply chain/market/sector etc.
